GULF COAST CLAIMS FACILITY NOW PROCESSING OIL SPILL CLAIMS

***INDEPENDENT ADMINISTRATOR KENNETH R. FEINBERG ANNOUNCES
TRANSFER COMPLETE AND CENTERS UP AND RUNNING***

Gulf Coast Claims Facility Administrator Kenneth R. Feinberg today announced the Gulf Coast Claims Facility (GCCF) is fully functioning and will begin to process claims for emergency payment. All individual and business claims and supporting documentation have been transferred from BP to the GCCF, which is an independent facility run by Feinberg.

The GCCF was established in June as part of an agreement between the Obama Administration and BP to assist claimants in filing claims for costs and damages incurred as a result of the oil spill stemming from the Deepwater Horizon Incident of April 20, 2010. Claims previously filed with the BP Claims Process have been transitioned to the new GCCF Claims Facility for review, evaluation

and determination, however claimants will be required to file new forms with the GCCF to receive payments.

Feinberg has participated in dozens of town hall meetings throughout the Gulf region since the announcement of the Fund and is working closely with state and local government to craft a claims process that benefits all those affected by the crisis.

"I want to make sure the people in the Gulf understand we will not let you go out of business or lose your home. The number one priority of the GCCF is to assist the people in the Gulf," said Feinberg. "Now that the claim centers are open and ready for business, the goal will be to get the emergency six month payment checks out the door, within 48 hours for individuals, after receipt of the claim form and sufficient supporting documentation and no more than seven days for businesses, after receipt of claim form and supporting documentation, and help people on the path to rebuilding their lives."
